**AN EMERGENCY INTERIM DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE DEFERRING ISSUANCE OF  
PERMITS FOR SHORT-TERM RENTALS PENDING DEVELOPMENT OF A  
COMPREHENSIVE REGULATORY ORDINANCE.**
